



## **POSITION VACANT: Junior Soils Technician**

Ground Science is looking for a junior / trainee soils technician to compliment their current team of skilled soil testers. The successful candidate will be enrolled at Swinburne Tafe by the company to complete a certificate iii in laboratory operations. Staff are encouraged and supported to continue studies as they develop skills in physical soils testing techniques. Opportunities exist to continue qualifications up to advanced diploma in laboratory operations.

The position involves the preparation of soil samples for routine laboratory testing, learning basic soil tests and learning to operate specific equipment. As a soil tester becomes competent at the basic tests on the job training is provided to expand their knowledge to a broader range of tests. With experience, staff may be promoted to field testing and operating highly technical nuclear densometer density/ moisture gauges. Training and licensing in safe use of these instruments is provided.
